

## Introduction to the FASL 28 extra issue

The articles in this volume arose from papers given at the 28th Workshop on Formal Approaches to Slavic Linguistics, which was held at Stony Brook University, May 3-5, 2019. Invited speakers were *Greville Corbett* (University of Surrey, UK), *Steven Franks* (Indiana University, Bloomington), and *Draga Zec* (Cornell University).
